

Early Years

- Date of Birth: August 6th, 1928
- Place of Birth: Pittsburgh, PA

- Childhood was spent in: Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania
- Interesting facts: He lived as a openly gay man,he authored many books like Popism: "The Warhol",and he was shot by radical feminist writer Valerie Solanas but he surived
- He, also at age eight got Chorea or St.Vitus's Dance a rare/fatal disease of the nervous system that left Andy sick in the bed is another interesting fact.

Education

- Andy attend Schenley High School and later graduating at 16 in 1945.
- Andy then attended Carnegie Institute of Technology graduating sooner later in 1949.

Adult-Early Years

- Andy moved to New York City after graduating.
- He choose to live in New York City so he could start his very successful career in commercial illustration.
- Where he made his first project for Glamour magazine for article, "Success is a Job in New York".

Early Years- Influences/Friends

- Andy Warhol had a close and good friend Jean-Michel Basquiat.He was also a painter.
- Warhol really liked Robert Rauschenberg and Jasper Johns which influenced him to expand his art work.
- Later in 1960, using comic strips and advertisement in his artwork.

- Mr.Warhol spouse was Edie Sedgwick she was born April 20,1943.
- Mr.Andrej Warhola andy's dad had gallbladder complications.
- Mrs.Julia Warhola andy's mother was healthy and had a huge influence on andy's life with her drawing and calligraphy.
- John Warhola got pneumonia and died but he played a huge role in andy's life by keeping him in school after his dad died

First work of art


- In 1961, Andy created his first piece of pop art which was based on comics and ads.
- This artwork didn't get him famous or wealthy but his 1961 Coca-Cola art piece was a important or pivotal piece in his career.
- His first pieces of artwork was in display in a New York department teller's window display.

- Andy painted the Campbell Soup Can because he enjoyed eating the soup, he apparently ate the soup everyday for lunch for 20 years.
- Created: 1969
- Size:1'8"×1'×4"
- Medium:Synthetic polymer paint on canvas
- Subject:Campbell Condensed Tomato Soup
- Support:Canvas
- Art movement: Pop art
